Dear Heartland Board of Directors and Heartland Limousin State Board of Directors,

It's hard to believe in just 8 months we will be hosting the 2017 National Jr. Limousin Show and Congress in Grand Island. In August, I had the privilege to tour the facilities in Grand Island and they are truly amazing! I've attached photos at the end of this letter for you to view and get an idea of what we will be working with in July.

In my last letter sent in the spring, we requested \$5,000 from each state in the Heartland Limousin Association for financial support of the show. To date, we have received the money from 2 states. I have opened an account here in Iowa, under the Iowa Limousin Association's supervision. The account is called **2017 Heartland National**Show. If your state has raised the money and would like to send me a check, please make it out to the above account

name. I would like all money sent **NO LATER than February 1st, 2017** as requested in my e-mail earlier this year.

Ann Vorthmann has already been doing an outstanding job of getting donations for food during the week of July 1–7. It is looking at this point that we will be able to provide several meals and still keep within budget. We will need volunteers from each state to help prepare, serve and clean up for each day meals are served. We NEED paper products!!! We are asking everyone to call on their local banks, seed dealers, co-ops, elevators, etc. for paper products in quantities of 500. This is not a hard thing to do as many of these businesses love to advertise! As you get these donations, please contact Brenda Anderson so that she can keep record of how much we have. Keep in mind; if we serve 10 meals throughout the week, then we will need 5000 cups, plates, silverware and napkins. The less we have to buy, the more money we can keep in the budget for other items for the week!! Please put in your state's newsletters that we need volunteers and paper products for meals!

I want to touch on financial information at this time. I am hoping everyone has seen the cattle show print project that Norma Effertz and Judy Symens have been working on to help supplement money for the National Show. Every year the host state (Heartland) has the option of auctioning something off at Genetics on Ice in Denver. The item the Heartland will be auctioning off is "a fence side pose of a person with their farm name/logo advertising on the back of their coat" in the print. Proceeds from this item will go back to the Heartland for the show.

Norma has advised me that there are several bleacher spots still available on the print. These spots cost \$100 and they can be a face shot of ANYONE! If each Heartland State works together these spaces can be filled very easily with just a few phone calls. If we can get just 5 faces from each Heartland State, that is 35 faces for the print and \$3,500 to go toward the National show!!! Please make an effort and call some of your members to get 5 faces for the print. When you have them, give the names and contact information to Norma Effertz 701-720-5236. She will send them a bill and collect the picture from the family.


Tie outs, photo of outside of buildings. Show Arena in the middle, cattle barn on the side.





We are using this space for hospitality. It is located on the end of the cattle barn. Food will be prepared in a large kitchen in another building and will be transported to this area for serving and eating.


